Volunteer Project Management

Companies interested in organizing volunteer opportunities for their employees turn to Volunteer Fairfax to provide complete project management. We have managed everything from one-time projects for 20 workers to annual company-wide events for more than 1,000 employees. In this fee-for-service arrangement, Volunteer Fairfax will work to solicit meaningful projects, provide liaison services with the selected nonprofit, gauge site supply needs and coordinate the procurement and distribution of supplies, provide promotional information to support employee volunteer recruitment, provide dedicated on-site staff during the project to maximize event day success, survey employees for their feedback and compile results into an after-action report. IMPACT Day is a national, firm-wide day of service which provides employees the opportunity to participate in locally-driven projects that support community needs. On Friday, June 11, 2010, more than 3,500 Washington area Deloitte employees volunteered at sixty-five projects and supported more than 80 different nonprofit organizations.

In 2010, the sixth year that Volunteer Fairfax supported Deloitte's IMPACT Day, the Center simultaneously managed eleven projects sites located in Alexandria, Annandale, Arlington, Chantilly, Fairfax, Falls Church, Haymarket, Herndon and Springfield. Volunteers

accomplished a tremendous amount; they completed a full inventory of an international aid organization's medical supply warehouse, cleaned and processed hundreds of donated eyeglasses, inventoried an on-site pharmacy, removed over 50 bags of invasive garlic mustard plants, spread mulch over 1.5 miles of trails at a local park, accompanied 200 residents who cannot walk without assistance through carnival-type activities around the campus of a senior home, evaluated over 200 Scholarship Essays for a college tuition competition and created more than 800 hand-made cards for care packages.

The Lockheed Martin Day of Service provides employees the opportunities to participate in locally-driven projects supporting community needs. In 2010, Volunteer Fairfax directly managed five different project sites: including projects located in Alexandria, Fairfax, Great Falls and Herndon. Accomplishments included assembling 200 care packages that were sent to our troops serving overseas along with 1,200 cards of encouragement; painting hundreds of yards of fence line at a therapeutic riding center; and creating one-of-a-kind quilts for children with deployed parents.

AOL Monster Help Day is a day of company-wide service composed of locally-driven projects that support the community. On Thursday, May 20, 2010, AOL employees participated in the first Monster Help Day to coincide with the company's 25th Anniversary celebration. Volunteer Fairfax managed more than 550 volunteers at seven different projects including sites located in Alexandria, Dulles, Herndon, Lorton, Manassas, Reston, and Washington D.C. Volunteer tasks included completing 30 unique and personalized scrapbooks for children involved in the Court

Appointed Special Advocates program; beautifying a facility serving children and families while serving meals for their 60 clients; and removing tons of invasive plants and trash from the W&OD and Sugarland trails.



Ernst & Young

Mid-Atlantic Cares Day is a regional day of service composed of locally-driven projects that make a difference in the community. On Friday, September 25, 2009, Ernst & Young employees from offices in Philadelphia, Baltimore, Washington, D.C., McLean, and Richmond took part in this day. Volunteer Fairfax managed more than 300 volunteers at eight different projects in the Metro D.C. area with employees from the McLean and Washington, D.C., offices. Locations included Annandale, Alexandria, Lorton, and Springfield in Virginia as well as Silver Spring,

Maryland and Washington, D.C. In 2010, the fourth year that Volunteer Fairfax worked with E&Y, volunteers installed thousands of lights for a holiday display (saving staff three weeks of work), sorted 28,200 pounds of food to be distributed to local agencies, interacted with residents at a local senior home, and taught lessons on financial literacy to 450 students in 24 classrooms.
