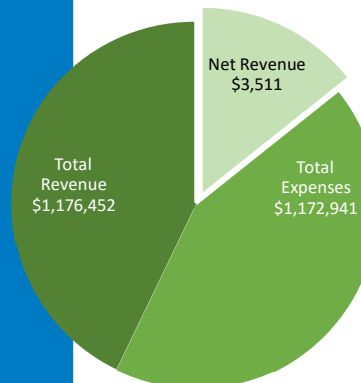
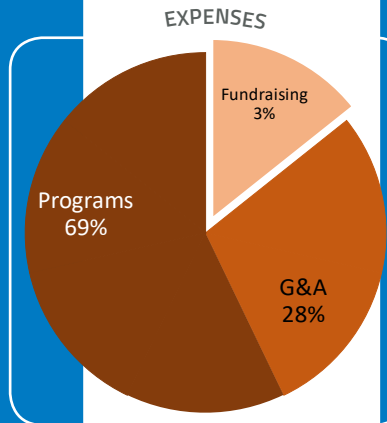
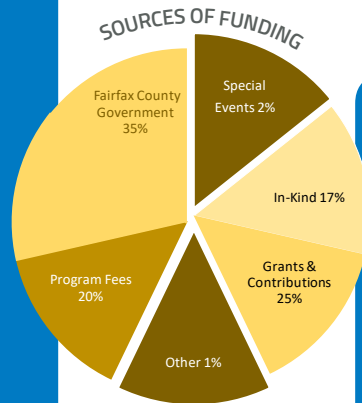
Volunteer Fairfax works closely with a broad array of community organizations to provide support to the county's community building objectives.

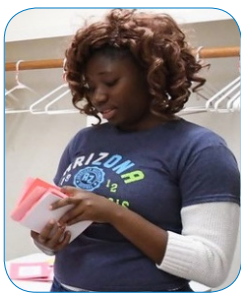
