What's the **Valentine's Challenge**?

The annual **Valentine's Challenge**, a program of Volunteer Fairfax's Volunteers for Change, gathers 450-500 volunteers to make valentines for children and youth in foster care or who have recently aged out. The day runs in two shifts (9:00-12:00 and 1:30-4:30) to accommodate families with children. The event is held at Station 3, Fairfax City Volunteer Fire Department, City of Fairfax. City leadership and other elected officials stop by and thank volunteers. Last year, 5,000 cards were created. Snacks and lunch are served to participants.

What's **Give Together**?

Hosted at the Jewish Community Center in Annandale, Virginia, **Give Together** brings together over 800 volunteers (particularly young families) to complete projects for local Fairfax County nonprofits. During one of the three shifts, children rotate through several mini-service projects, having a passport stamped at each station. At the conclusion, children will see the difference that their many hands can make on a community by their completed projects.
