

# CMA Technology Impact Report



## What We Did:

CMA employees and family members worked together for a span of 2 hours at Food For Others by completing various tasks in their food distribution center. They assembled and did quality control of around 400 Power Packs as well as sorted and organized 2 large crates of new food donations.

## The Impact:

By volunteering, CMA's team has helped contribute to Food For Other's programs and mission. Food For Others serves 60,000 individuals annually, and 3,800 of these individuals are students who continually receive the ready-made Power Packs to ensure they have meals for the weekend. Having volunteered around the holidays, CMA helped manage the Food For Other's holiday rush and give a hand to the community they serve.
